Demolition: Security operatives injure Glo, NDDC managers in Rivers

C OLDIERS and armed Opolicemes on Tuesday beat up the Zonal Manger of Glo Mobile Limited, in Post Harcourt, Rivers State, Mr. Ibrahim Sugit, and a Principal Manager with the Niger Delta Development Commission whose name could not be ascertained by press time.

Our correspondent learnt that trouble started when officials of the Rivers State Ministry of Urban Development, led by a director, went to the Gio regional office to demolish a parameter fence which was constructed beyond the legal

On arrival at the premises that shares a boundary with

the NDDC headquarters complex, a lady, whose office close to the telecommunications office. said the demolition team set to work with their buildowrs. and trailers.

But just as the buildowns. started pulling down the ferror, located on Aba Road Expressway, some staff of the telecommunications firm started seconding it with their mobile phones and cameras.

According to the source. the leader of the demolition. team was piqued by the development and demanded to know who authorised the recording.

Our sources said it was at that juncture, that the acreal manager of the telecoms fem. came out to identify himself and said he ordered the recording.

Angered by the audacity of the manager, the state official gripped him by the shirt collar. dragging him. The official also ordered his staff to "deal" with some staff of the firm, who had come to rescue their collengue.

Shrand, "They came with buildozers and nobody stopped them from pulling down the tence. What actually brought the problem was when people started recording the demolition."
